PRACTICE-I

Title of the practice: **Compulsory Spoken English and Personality Development Course.**

The Objective: To help students enhance their ability to communicate in the lingua franca of the business/ corporate world.

The Context: The college admits many students who are unable to communicate in English owing to a lack of training. This prevents them from actively participating in the business world.

The Practice: In the very first semester the students learn nuances of the English language which include the four skills of listening, reading, writing, and speaking.

Evidence of Success: Student informal feedback has been very encouraging.

Problems Encountered: Lack of infrastructure. Limitations of funds.

PRACTICE – II

Title of the Practice: **Compulsory Computer Awareness Programme.**

Objectives: To help students overcome digital divide through computer literacy.

Context: Many students have little proficiency in basic IT tools to function efficiently in the new knowledge ecosystem.

Practice: The students learn the basics of operating system, word processing, computer networks, and internet security. The curriculum also covers how to work with functions, data-analysis & graphical representation (charts).

Evidence of Success: Many departments acknowledge positive shift in the quality of student's presentations and project works.

Problems Encountered: The programme is capital intensive; the number of students is overwhelmingly big.
