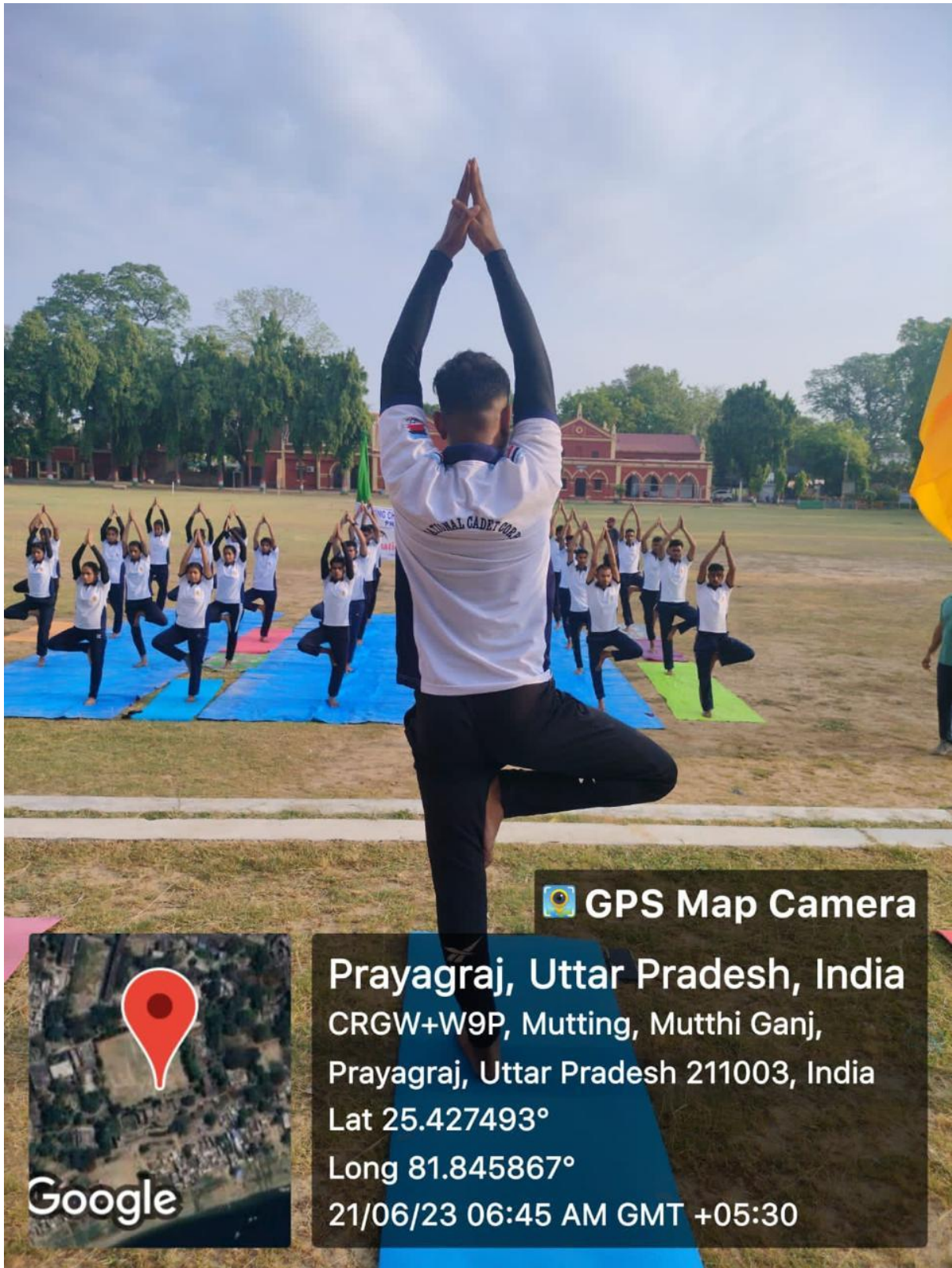

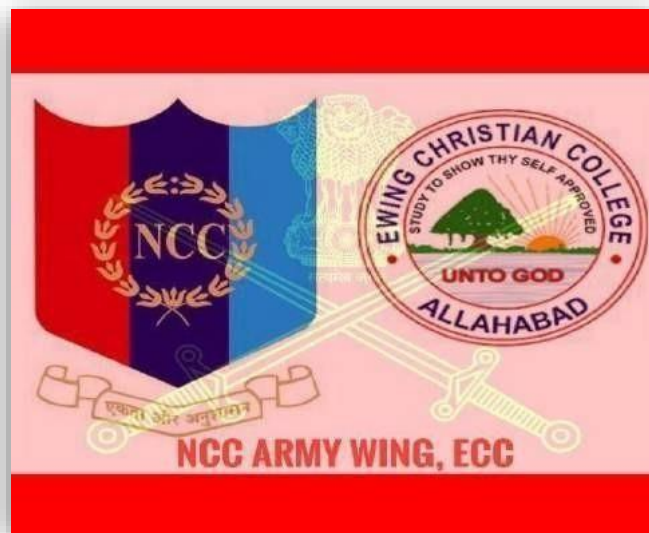
The National Cadet Corps is the Indian military cadet corps with its Headquarters at New Delhi. It is open to school and college students on voluntary basis. National Cadet Corps is a Tri-Services Organization, comprising the Army, Navy and Air Force, engaged in grooming the youth of the country into disciplined and patriotic citizens. The National Cadet Corps in India is a voluntary organization that recruits cadets from high schools, colleges and Universities all over India. The Cadets are given basic military training in small arms and parades. The officers and cadets have no liability for active military service once they complete their course but are given preference over normal candidates during selections based on the achievements in the corps.

The aims of NCC is to develop character, commandership, discipline, Leadership, secular outlook, spirit of adventure, sportsmanship and ideals of Selfless service among the youth of the country; to create a human resource of Organized, trained and motivated youth to provide leadership in all lifestyles In addition, always be available for the service of the nation; to provide a suitable Environment to motivate the youth to take up a career in the Armed Forces.

In 1949, the Girls Division was raised in order to give equal opportunities to school and college going girls. The NCC was given an inter-service image in 1950 when the Air Wing was added, followed by the Naval Wing in 1952. Same year, the NCC curriculum was extended to include community development/social service activities as a part of the NCC syllabus at the behest of Late Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru who took keen interest in the growth of the NCC. Following the 1962 Sino-Indian War, to meet the requirement of the Nation, the NCC training was made

compulsory in 1963. In 1968, the Corps was again made voluntary.

NCC in the college plays a credible role in shaping the character of students By instilling the values of patriotism, service, discipline and hard work. NCC insists qualities like nationalism, patriotism, discipline, team spirit, Leadership, self-confidence and promote overall personality development. NCC gives a tremendous opportunity to all betterment, irrespective of caste, creed, religion and economic status. Based on the aims of NCC; the organization has laid down training syllabi for cadets. The syllabus for the Senior Division Cadets covers a period of three years. Except for minor, the syllabus for each division is similar for boy and girl cadets. The training year matches the academic and financial year.



Ewing Christian College (ECC) was established in 1902. Since then it has become one of the premier colleges for excellence in higher education and research in India.

National Cadet Corps existed in Ewing Christian College since 1950s to ignite the minds of cadets with the motto - UNITY AND DISCIPLINE to develop qualities of character, courage, comradeship, discipline, leadership, secular outlook, spirit of adventure, ideals of selfless service and bring peace, prosperity and bliss to the nation.

Below she has shared her experienced about OTA camp.

'NCC', it's not just an organisation but a life which transforms you into a totally different person and that's what happened to me as well and all the other cadets who were selected for the OTA ATT Camp.

As APJ Abdul Kalam once said, 'All of us do not have equal talent, but all of us have equal opportunity to develop our talents'. With this quote he surely meant that we should never leave any opportunity to excel ourselves. One such opportunity came to me knocking on the door - 'The OTA ATT Camp' that was organised at OTA, Chennai. 'OTA Chennai' must be a dream of thousands of defence aspirants but being lucky enough very few get the chance of visiting there before succeeding in their entrance exam. But then, they say 'Great dreams of great dreamers are always transcended' and so did my dream of going to OTA.

The journey began on 31st October 2022 itself, as we two cadets of Prayagraj group boarded the Bundelkhand Express and headed towards Virangana Lakshmbai. I was quite nervous and curious about how the camp would go. We Reached Virangana

Lakshmbai on 1st November 2022 and were made to stay at 32 UP (G) BN NCC till we board again towards Chennai. On the same night we headed towards Chennai. We were 15 cadets of UP Directorate together now.

We reached Chennai on 3rd November 2022. When I saw the entrance gate OTA for the first time my heart skipped a beat. I couldn't get my eyes off it; I wasn't able to believe my own eyes that I finally made it till here after all those interviews that I once thought I won't even clear. It was our first day at OTA and the heavy rainfall cancelled our plans for 'OTA Prashan'. We were made to stay in Hajipir Coy. We made friends from various other directorates. The ones living with us in our barrack were from Andhra Pradesh, Telangana and Uttrakhand respectively.

As we were here in the world of ragdas and drills, how could we be spared? Our schedule for the next few days (9 to be specific) came, that included early morning PT/ Drill/ OT which taught us the importance of physical exercise, coordination and making balance between mind and body. After the PT/Drill we had our breakfast at 08:00 am and afterwards classes were scheduled till 1300 hrs, where they taught us about the wars and army history. Be it the PIS or the officers during our theory classes, all of them aimed to build a leader in all of us. I still remember the words of Captain Mohit Gautam, as he says 'It's not necessary for a manager to be a good leader but it is very much important for a leader to be a good manager.' Between all these classes about war history, another skill that cadets learned among themselves was being attentive while taking naps.

On the third day of the camp, i.e., 5th November 2022 we were issued bicycles to cover long distances in the campus during activities such as Games in the evening for which we needed to cross the Adyan river.

One of the most beautiful and precious moment for all of us was the light show organised at White House - 'White House Talks'. It was a show where we got to know about the academy from the oldest building - The White House, itself. Being not strict with us, the academy also organised 'Chennai Pradarshan' for all of us on Sunday, during which we visited Chennai's most famous 'Marina Beach', 'St. Mary's Church' and 'The Fort Museum'. The day ended with a beautiful sunset at the beach.

We were also taken to the firing range where we were introduced with various weapons, especially INSAS, that we were about to fire with for the very first time. Two days were dedicated to the firing session, so that we get to know INSAS better. Two days were dedicated to the firing session, so that we get to know INSAS better.

We also went to the museum inside OTA where we learned about the men who sacrificed their lives for the nation, the history of OTA and the medals of various heroes of our nation. As many directions were leaving on 12th Nov 2022 itself, the plan/schedule of 12th Nov was preponed to 11th Nov 2022. On that day we had our photograph clicked and visited to few more places in OTA that were new to us.

Though it was raining since morning, we walked forward and went to the equitation area to see the 37 horses serving at OTA, two of them were Sultan and Tomar. Then we headed towards the WC accommodation area where we saw the clean and disciplined area followed by the P-Hill visit. P-Hill, also called Punishment Hill by the cadets training there, gave a proper aerial view of the OTA along with the airport. We also got pictures clicked there with Captain Aparna Rai, who have made all these visits possible for us. After all the visits we went back to our barracks and dried ourselves up. The training at OTA had come to an end that day. At the end of it we had made several friends among those 100 cadets who came from all over India.

And OTA has motivated us to be strong and disciplined in our lives and never give up, no matter how difficult the obstacle is.

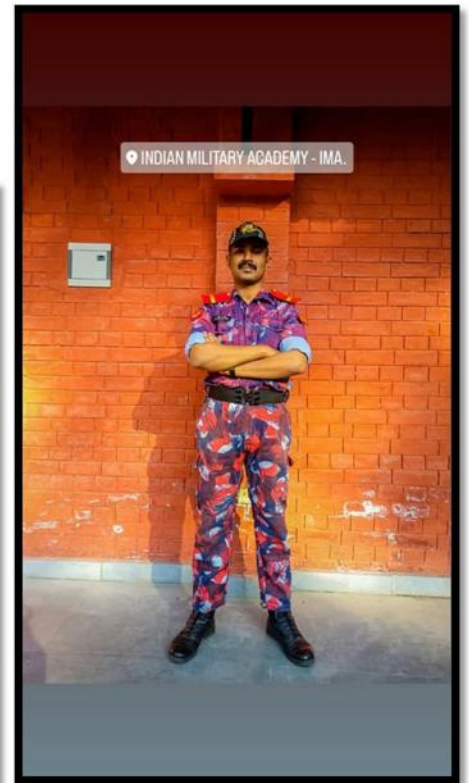

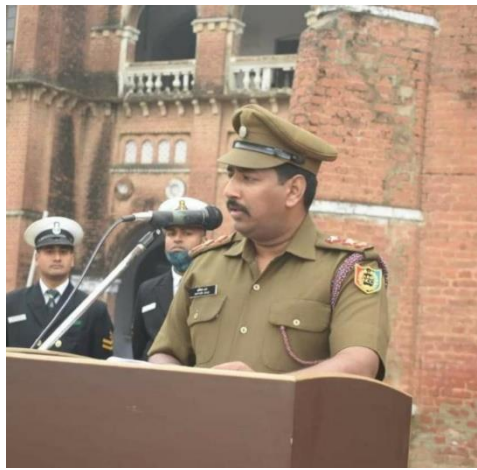

NCC Annual Report 2021-22



The National Cadet Corps is the Indian military cadet corps with its Headquarters at **New Delhi**. It is open to school and college students on voluntary basis. **National Cadet Corps is a Tri Services Organization, comprising the Army, Navy and Air Force**, engaged in grooming the youth of the country into disciplined and patriotic citizens. The National Cadet Corps in India is a voluntary organization that recruits cadets from high schools, colleges and Universities all over India. The Cadets are given basic military training in small arms and parades. The officers and cadets have no liability for active military service once they complete their course but are given preference over normal candidates during selections based on the achievements in the corps. **The aims of NCC is to develop character, commandership, discipline, Leadership, secular outlook, spirit of adventure, sportsmanship and ideals of Selfless service among the youth of the country**; to create a human resource of Organized, trained and motivated youth to provide leadership in all lifestyles In addition, always be available for the service of the nation; to provide a suitable Environment to motivate the youth to take up a career in the Armed Forces. In 1949, the Girls Division was raised in order to give equal opportunities to school and college going girls. The NCC was given an inter-service image in 1950 when the Air Wing was added, followed by the Naval Wing in 1952. Same year, the NCC curriculum was extended to include community development/social service activities as a part of the NCC syllabus at the behest of Late Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru who took keen interest in the growth of the NCC. Following the 1962 Sino-Indian War, to meet the requirement of the Nation, the NCC training was made compulsory in 1963. In 1968, the Corps was again made voluntary.



NCC in the college plays a credible role in shaping the character of students By instilling the values of patriotism, service, discipline and hard work. NCC insists qualities like nationalism, patriotism, discipline, team spirit, Leadership, self-confidence and promote overall personality development. NCC gives a tremendous opportunity to all betterment, irrespective of caste, creed, religion and economic status. Based on the aims of NCC; the organization has laid down training syllabi for cadets. The syllabus for the Senior Division Cadets covers a period of three years. Except for minor, the syllabus for each division is similar for boy and girl cadets. The training year matches the academic and financial year. Ewing Christian College (ECC) was established in 1902. Since then, it has become one of the premier colleges for excellence in higher education and research in India. National Cadet Corps existed in Ewing Christian College since 1950s to ignite the minds of cadets with the motto - **UNITY AND DISCIPLINE** to develop qualities of character, Coverage, comradeship, discipline, leadership, secular outlook, spirit of adventure, ideals of selfless service and bring peace, prosperity and bliss to the nation. **The Army Wing Unit, National Cadet Corps of Ewing Christian College was raised this year under the aegis of 16 UP Bn. Dr. Amitabh Shad was appointed as the Associated NCC Officer (ANO) of this NCC Army Unit, ECC** and took over the charge as care taking officer initially with 51 cadets in NCC army wing ECC. 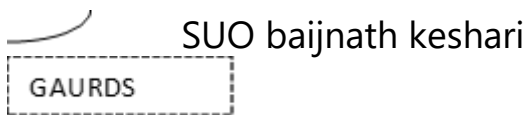

army wing of ECC. Among these 180 students total 17 cadets were selected after running and physical test that was held on 30/11/21 and 06/12/21 respectively.

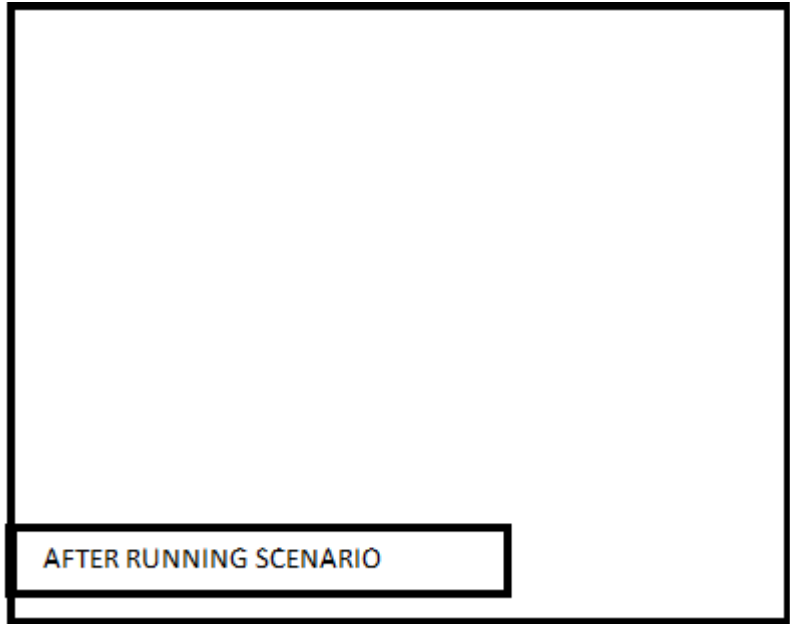

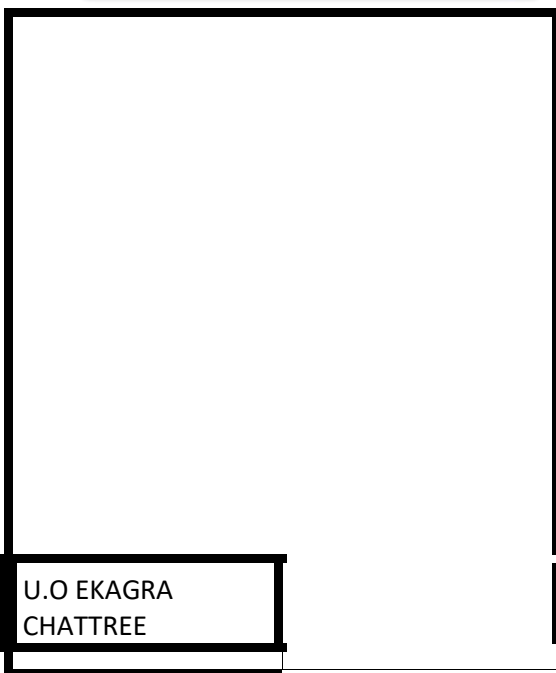

HERE'S HIS EXPERIENCE IN THE SHOOTING EVENT:

Akashdeep, Officer-in-charge of the competition, would interact with the participants, boost their morale, motivate them, and elaborate about life in the armed forces.

After the competition and the declaration of results, a prize distribution ceremony was organized to honour the top performers, followed by a special lunch.

I was among the 52 cadets who were selected to be a part of the NCC Shooting Team and represent the Cadet Corps in the All India G.V. Mavalankar Shooting Championship organised by the National Rifles Association of India (NRAI), to be held in Ahmedabad, Gujarat. Before leaving Indore, we went through intense training at a specialized Military Unit to prepare us physically, mentally, and psychologically.

Upon reaching Ahmedabad, we were wholeheartedly received by members of 1 Gujarat Battalion and were taken to the Ahmedabad Group Headquarters. We were welcomed by the Commanding Officer of 1Guj Battalion, Lt. Col Sateesh Kumar, who briefed us on the major details of the event. Our daily routine consisted of early morning PT, rigorous self-

practice, and coaching sessions. We were also allotted recreational time in the evening to play sports and wind down. We also got to interact with Major General Arvind Kapoor, Additional Directorate General NCC Gujarat Dte, who was impressed upon witnessing the cadets in high spirits and motivated, he expressed his best wishes and exhorted all the cadets to give their best in the shooting competition.

The competition was conducted at the Ahmedabad Military & Rifle Training Association, in which every team member performed exceptionally well and was congratulated by the Association members.

After the competition, a special dinner was organized by the Ahmedabad Group to appreciate the hard work and the achievement of the team. We were all delighted at the successful completion of the camp, but at the same time, we were feeling bittersweet because we have lived together as a family all these days, and we knew that we would part soon. We enjoyed our final days of the camp by exploring the city and visiting various places of attractions.

This camp taught me the value of teamwork, the meaning of the statement- “All for one, one for all”, it taught me how easily a person can adapt to various situations, and ultimately made me a better person. I witnessed a Mini India in such a short span and got to meet numerous military officials. I returned with a heap full of memories, lessons, and a lot of new friends.

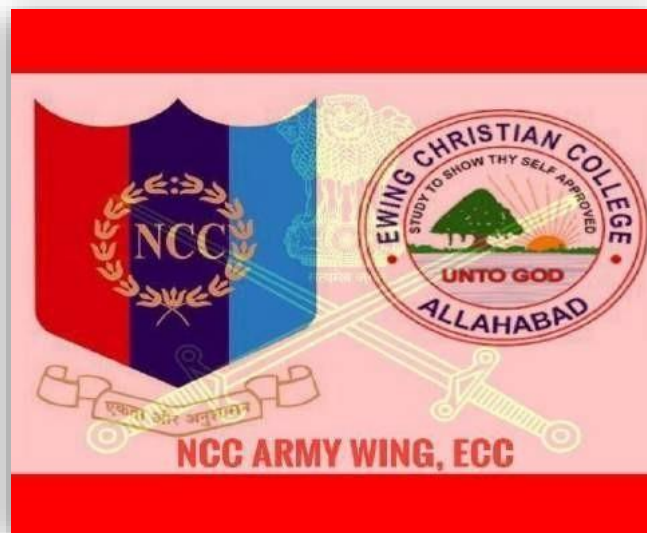

The aims of NCC is to develop character, commandership, discipline, Leadership, secular outlook, spirit of adventure, sportsmanship and ideals of Selfless service among the youth of the country; to create a human resource of Organized, trained and motivated youth to provide leadership in all lifestyles In addition, always be available for the service of the nation; to provide a suitable Environment to motivate the youth to take up a career in the Armed Forces.

In 1949, the Girls Division was raised in order to give equal opportunities to school and college going girls. The NCC was given an inter-service image in 1950 when the Air Wing was added, followed by the Naval Wing in 1952. Same year, the NCC curriculum was extended to include community development/social service activities as a part of the NCC syllabus at the behest of Late Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru who took keen interest in the growth of the NCC. Following the 1962 Sino-Indian War, to meet the requirement of the Nation, the NCC training was made

compulsory in 1963. In 1968, the Corps was again made voluntary.

NCC in the college plays a credible role in shaping the character of students By instilling the values of patriotism, service, discipline and hard work. NCC insists qualities like nationalism, patriotism, discipline, team spirit, Leadership, self-confidence and promote overall personality development. NCC gives a tremendous opportunity to all betterment, irrespective of caste, creed, religion and economic status. Based on the aims of NCC; the organization has laid down training syllabi for cadets. The syllabus for the Senior Division Cadets covers a period of three years. Except for minor, the syllabus for each division is similar for boy and girl cadets. The training year matches the academic and financial year.



Ewing Christian College (ECC) was established in 1902. Since then it has become one of the premier colleges for excellence in higher education and research in India.

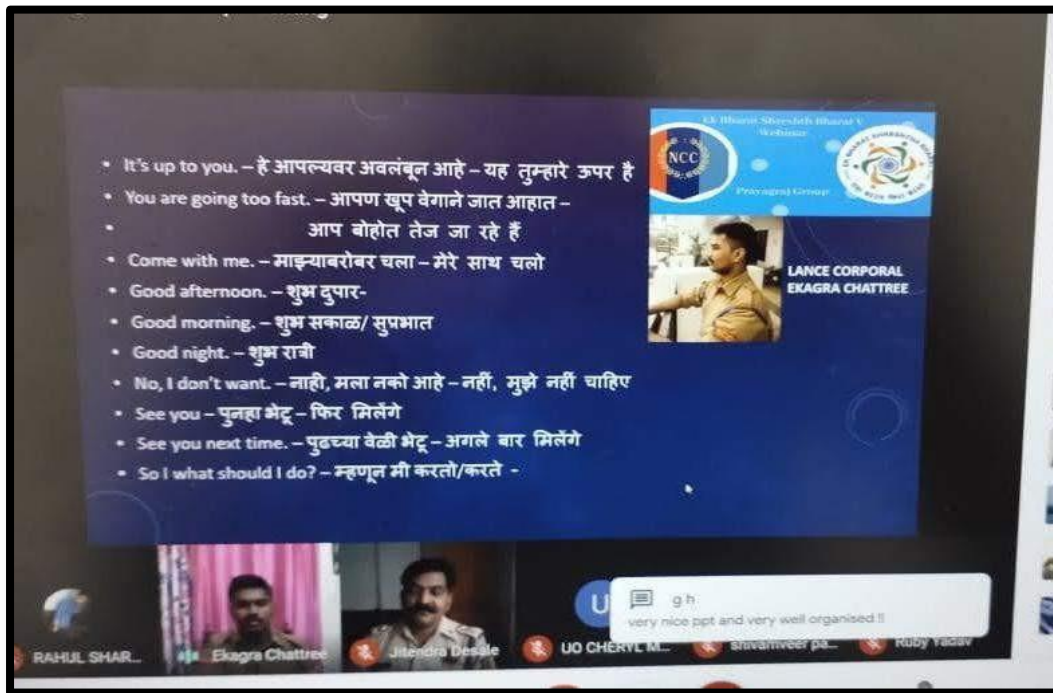
