IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING FORMAT OF INTERNAL ASSESSMENT TEST QUESTION PAPER FOR B.A., B.Sc. & B.Com. REGULAR & EX-STUDENTS SEMESTER – I SESSION 2025-2026

All the **Regular and Ex-students** students of **B.A., B.Sc. & B.Com. Semester I** of Academic Session **2025–2026** are hereby reminded that as per the pre-announced Time Table, **Internal Assessment Test of Semester I** of all subjects (Theory Courses only) will begin from **Saturday 25.10.2025 onwards**.

The **Time Table** for the same is already uploaded on the college website for information to all stakeholders. All students are advised to go through the following information regarding the format of Internal Assessment Test Question Paper in order to avoid any inconvenience and confusion.

1. All **Regular and Ex-students** students of **B.A., B.Sc. & B.Com. Semester I** of Academic Session **2025–2026** are hereby informed that they are expected to carry their **latest Fee receipt** as a mark of identity during the entire course of Internal Assessment Test failing which they may not be permitted to appear in Test for which they will be singly responsible.
2. Students to note that there is no provision for Second Examination in Internal Assessment Tests therefore students should ensure that they appear in Internal Assessment Tests.
3. Multiple Choice Question/Objective type paper with no negative marking.
4. There will be four options in each question, out of which one will be the correct answer.
5. Duration of examination is One hour for each subject (including both Paper I & II) without gap.
6. A single booklet containing questions from both papers of a **major subject** will be given to students along with an OMR Sheet which will be used for writing the correct answers. The same will be collected at the end of the Test.
7. In case of **minor subjects**, students will be given a booklet containing questions from their minor subject along with an OMR Sheet which will be used for writing the correct answers. The same will be collected at the end of the Test.
8. Arts & Humanities question papers (except language subjects) will be Bilingual (English & Hindi).
9. Science and B.Com. question papers will be only in English.
10. Question Paper format is as follows:

For all B.A./B.Sc. (Practical Subjects)

- **MAJOR SUBJECTS (For One Paper)**
20 questions x 1.25 marks per question = 25 marks
Duration = 30 min for one paper
- **MINOR SUBJECTS**
20 questions x 1.25 marks per question = 25 marks
Duration = 30 min

For all B.A./B.Sc. (Non-Practical Subjects)

- **MAJOR SUBJECTS (For One Paper)**

20 questions x 1.50 marks per question = 30 marks

Duration = 30 min for one paper

- **MINOR SUBJECTS**

20 questions x 1.50 marks per question = 30 marks

Duration = 30 min

For B.Com.

- **For each Major/Minor Paper**

20 questions x 1.50 marks per question = 30 marks

Duration = 30 min per paper

11. Use of mobile phones, earplugs/buds. Bluetooth devices, digital watch or any other such device is not permitted inside the Examination Hall. If any student is found possessing it in person or using it during the course of Examination, all college examination rules related to use of unfair means will be applicable on them.

12. If any student is charged with indiscipline or misbehaviour with room invigilators or any other college staff, all college examination rules related to use of unfair means will be applicable on them.
